### JobsPlus

A potential grant (paid monthly over 2 years) to an employer who employs someone in receipt of Jobseekers Allowance or one parent family payment (eligibility and payment level conditional on age, status and time in receipt of payment) Call us for guidance and see <https://www.gov.ie/en/service/662090-jobsplus-online-application-for-employers/>

### Wage Subsidy Scheme

The Wage Subsidy Scheme gives financial incentives to private sector employers to employ people with a disability. The work offered must be for a minimum of 21 hours per week and the subsidy is available up to 39 hours per week. ### Work Placement Experience Programme

The Work Placement Experience Programme (WPEP) is a 6-month, 30 hour per week voluntary work experience programme. The programme is for jobseekers that are currently getting a qualifying social welfare payment and who have been unemployed for six months (156 days) or more.
